Our "Last Litter Program" is an incentive created to reduce the impact that unplanned litters have on owner's lives, community resources and the animal welfare sector.

We actively work with community members to ensure we prioritise the health and well being of their pets by offering:

- FREE desexing of the parent dogs
- Providing <u>premium quality puppy food</u> and worming to parents and pups during the puppy raising period
- Ensuring <u>all pups are desexed, microchipped and vaccinated</u> at the time of rehoming via our community based foster care network

Any pregnant dog or mother dog is able to receive the benefits of this program.

The only criteria for approval to enter the program are:

1. We ask that all mother dogs are desexed (at our cost) when the pups are surrendered into our program at 8 weeks of age

2. And we require all pups from the litter to be surrendered into our care

If you or someone you know has a litter of pups that they would like assistance with, or if you work in a sector where you service the needs of vulnerable members of our community we would love to extend our offer of assistance.

We guarantee the very best start to life for pups who may otherwise perpetuate the cycle of unplanned pregnancies and accidental litters.
